The Colour Party should begin the routine at the rear right of the hall, side by side, facing towards the front and standing at ease. Movement of the Colour will not require a command but should be carried out smartly in the simplest manner without loss of bearing and with the left hand being used as necessary. It will be necessary for the Colour Bearer to memorise the commands for this drill routine. Between each section, the Colour Bearer should await signal from the judge before continuing. Marks will be awarded for uniform (10), commands (20) and drill movements (70).

Movement of the Colour should be carried out smartly in the simplest manner without loss of bearing and with the left hand being used as necessary. It will be necessary for the Senior Colour Bearer to memorise the commands for this drill routine. Between each section, the Senior Colour Bearer should await signal from the judge before continuing. Marks will be awarded for uniform (10), commands (20) and drill movements (70).
