The Sermon on The Mount

Round 1 Chapter 3

Q.1 Who preached “Repent , for the Kingdom of Heaven is near”?

A. Ch 3 v 1 John the Baptist.

Q.2. John baptized the people with water. What did he say the one who came after him would baptize with?

A. Ch 3 v 11 With the Holy Spirit and fire.

Q.3 When Jesus came to him to be baptized , what did John say to try and change Jesus’ mind?

A. Ch3 v14 John said that it should be Jesus baptising Him.

Q.4 What did Jesus SEE when he came out of the water?

A Ch 3 v16 Heaven opened and the Spirit of God descended like a dove.

Q. What did the voice from heaven SAY?

A Ch 3 v 16 “This is my Son with whom I am pleased.”

Round 2 Chapter 4

Q1. When the Devil suggested that Jesus turn the stones into bread, what is Jesus answer?

A. Ch 4 v4 "Man cannot live by bread alone but needs every word that God speaks."

Q2 . The Devil tempted Jesus to throw himself off the highest point of the Temple to prove he is God's son. What does Jesus say?

A. Ch 4 v 7 "Do not put your God to the test"

Q3. The Devil offered to give Jesus all the kingdoms of this earth if He will worship him. What does Jesus say?

A Ch4 v 10. "Worship the Lord your God and serve only Him."

Q. 4 Jesus then walked beside Lake Galilee and met four fishermen who became His disciples. Name 2 of these men.

A Ch4 v18 Simon (called Peter), Andrew, James and John

Q. Jesus then travelled all over Galilee. What was he doing?

A. Ch4 v23 He taught in the synagogues, preached the Good News about the kingdom and healed people from all kinds of Sickness and Disease.

Round 3 Chapter 5

Q1. In the Beatitudes who will be called the Children / Sons of God?

A. Ch 5 v9 The peacemakers.

Q2. Jesus told his disciples they should be like two things. What were they?

A. Ch 5 v 13 & 14 Salt & Light.

Q.3. What did Jesus say those wishing to give gifts to God should do first?

A. Ch 5 v 23 & 24 Be at peace with their brother.

Q.4. Old Testament teaching said “An eye for an eye, a tooth for a tooth”
What was Jesus’ teaching on revenge?

A. Ch 5 v 38 & 39 Do not take revenge, turn the other cheek.

Q. How did Jesus say we should treat our enemies?

A. Ch 5 v43 & 44 “Love your enemies, pray for those who persecute you”.

Round 4 Chapter 6

Q1 Jesus provides rules for giving to the needy. How should we give to the poor/needy?

A. Ch 6 v2-4 In private.. so that only you and the Lord know about it.

Q2 . During the “Sermon on the Mount” Jesus gave us the words which are still used in services today. We call it ‘The Lord’s Prayer’. How does it start?

A. Ch 6 v 9 ‘Our Father in heaven, hallowed be thy name’

Q3. What does Jesus say might happen to treasure stored on earth?

A. Ch 6 v 19 .Moths and rust can destroy, robbers break in and steal.

Q.4 What will happen if we try to serve 2 masters? What 2 masters does Jesus mention?

A.Ch 6 v24. We will love one and hate the other. God and Money.

Q, Why does Jesus say the disciples should not worry about food, drink and clothes?

A. Ch 6 v 32 God knows that they needed those things and if they look to Him first , then all those things would be given them.

Round 5 Chapter 7

Q1. How does Jesus say we will be judged?

A. Ch 7 v 2 God will apply the same rules as we use to judge others.

Q2. How does Jesus describe false prophets?

A. Ch 7 v15 As wolves in sheep's clothing.

Q3 . What sentence sums up the meaning of the Law of Moses and the Prophets?

A. Ch 7 v12 "Do for others what you would have them do for you".

Q4. Jesus tells a story to describe those who were listening to his teaching. What was this story about?

A. Ch 7 v 24 – 27 Two house builders and where they built their houses.

Q. At the end of these teachings, what did the crowd say about Jesus?

A. Ch 7 v 28 That he wasn't like other teachers of the law. He taught with authority.

Spare Questions.

Round 1. Ch3

Q. What did John the Baptist wear?

A. Ch3 v 4 Clothes made of camel's hair and a leather belt.

Round 2. Ch 4

Q. How long had Jesus been fasting when he was tempted by the Devil?

A . Ch4 v 2, 40 days and 40 nights

Round 3 Ch 5

Q. Jesus told his disciples that they would be persecuted because of Him, but they would receive a reward. Where?

A. Ch 5 v11& 12 In Heaven

Round 4 Ch 6

Q. Where should we pray?

A. Ch 6 vs 1& 6 In our rooms, in private/ secret. Not on street corners to be seen by men.

Round 5 Ch 7

Q. What will happen to the tree that does not bear fruit?

A. Ch7 v 19 A tree that doesn't bear fruit will be cut down and thrown in the fire.

We would like the Bible Quiz to be an event that as many young people can take part in as possible. Please try to make it an enjoyable experience for them all, and although we will present awards to the highest scoring teams in London District, we would be grateful if you could ensure that every person feels that they have achieved something worthwhile, whatever their contribution.

We are holding the Quiz as a “take part when and where it suits you” event within certain parameters. We are giving detailed instructions. (We apologise if some instructions are very obvious. Please bear with us, some may not have taken part before, your comments on how it works/ any problems encountered are sought when your result sheets are returned)

When should the quiz be held: -

Any day and time between **Sunday 17th and Sunday 31st March 2019**

Where should it be held: -

This will depend upon how many teams are to take part. If there is only one team, then one room will be sufficient. If there is to be more than one team, then those teams waiting to have their turn should wait where they cannot hear the previous teams answering the questions.

Those who have had their turn should not tell the others what the questions, answers or subject matter is. Best not to discuss the matter if they are anywhere near the others. If there are several teams, then suitable arrangement should be made to occupy the teams before or after they have their turn.

The Teams: -

All team members must be Company /Senior Section age. (None over or under age). You can enter as many teams as you wish. Number teams from the same Company A, B, C, etc.

Boys/girls may only take part once.

Ideally, Teams should be made up of Four Boys, Four Girls or Mixed teams. *(Results from teams of three will be included in the results.)*

Members can be from BB/GB/GA

Please state if Girls are GB, GA, or whatever. And the unit name of the girls group if it has one.

Number members of each team 1-4. Number 1 should be the captain. Sit them in a row in front of the QM's table.

(If a team has only three members the other members of the team should take it in turns to answer question 4 in each round)

List the team member's names and ages on the quiz sheet.

Question Master: -

You will require a suitable person to act as Question Master. He or she might be a minister, church member, BB/GB Officer.

What is important is that they present a friendly and sympathetic manner, and ask the questions in a way that will encourage the children, and be supportive, whatever the responses.

Please give the QM a chance to read these instructions and questions in advance. The QM when asking the questions must stick to reading the question as written. It may be repeated as many times as necessary.

The QM should only use whole marks. (i.e. 2,1 or 0. Only give a mark if all parts of the answer are given)

The Questions: -

The question paper has five sets of questions.

Each set has four questions, to be asked to each of the four boys/girls.

Question 1 to be asked to team member 1 (the Captain)

Question 2 to be asked to team member 2

And so on. There are two points for a correct individual answer

There must be **NO** assistance to the individual, from the other members of the team. (If the QM has to deal with an over enthusiastic person who blurts out an answer when it is not their turn, then the QM may consider it to be a Team response and ask the Captain what answer they wish to give on behalf of the Team for a maximum of one point instead of two.)

(If a team has only three members the other members of the team should take it in turns to answer question 4 in each round)

If the individual team member gets the question wrong, or cannot answer, the question becomes a team question, for one point. The QM must insist that the team Captain gives the teams answer, after consulting with their team, if necessary. (Encourage individuals to give an answer, as they do not lose anything if they are wrong.)

The fifth question, in each set is a team question for a maximum of two points. (The same rule applies that the answer must come from the Team Captain.) There are 25 questions with a maximum of 50 points.

We have put some "spare questions" at the end. Only use these in emergency. (e.g. The QM reads the answer as well as the question [it has happened]).

You may wish to have a local "tie break", if you want to have a definite local result. In which case please do not add this to the points you send in.

Please photocopy a separate question paper for each team.

Return the papers to the address below within two days of your Quiz.

(If you can, keep a copy in case of postal difficulties) We need all the papers to compile a complete London District list, and to assess the suitability of the
